# Township of Whitehall

### **Temporary Public Service Sign(s) Policy**

- 1.) A permit is required to place a Temporary Public Service Sign(s) on public lands under the control or maintained by Whitehall Township. The permit will be issued only to recognized Whitehall Township Organizations such as the Historical Society, the Volunteer Fire Department, the Emergency Management Department and all Park and Playground Organizations, etc.
- 2.) The permit is available at the Whitehall Township Municipal Building and on the Township web site at <a href="https://www.whitehalltownship.org">www.whitehalltownship.org</a>
- 3.) The permit will be reviewed by the Mayor or in his/her absence the Deputy Mayor.
- 4.) The applicant may not place any sign(s) until the Temporary Public Service Sign(s) permit application has been approved and signed by the Mayor or in his/her absence the Deputy Mayor.
- 5.) Temporary Public Service Signage must meet the same criteria and be in compliance with all zoning regulations (Refer to the Whitehall Township Zoning Code).
- 6.) The applicant must indicate on the application the wording or design of the sign(s). The Mayor or in his/her absence, the Deputy Mayor, reserves the right to withhold approval for any temporary sign(s) deemed to be inappropriate.
- 7.) The applicant agrees to hold harmless the Township of Whitehall, all elected officials, employees or volunteers in the erection or removal of such temporary public service sign(s).
- 8.) The Temporary Public Service Sign(s) may only be erected two weeks prior to the event and must be removed within one week after the event's conclusion.
