Goals

The Whitehall Historical Preservation Society was named and incorporated in 1984 to provide planning, funding, management and general oversight for the advancement and preservation of Whitehall Township's heritage. As a non-profit organization its goals are to:

- Restore and preserve the Helfrich Springs Grist Mill and the Peter Grim Homestead
- Advocate the preservation of historically significant structures and sites within Whitehall Township
- Provide a historical and genealogical library
- Collect, archive, preserve and display items from Whitehall Township's past
- Promote public awareness of our history
- Provide educational programs to schools and the community

Directions

From Route 22, take Route 145/MacArthur Road exit, south toward Seventh Street. In .5 mile turn right onto Jordan Parkway. At the stop sign make a right onto Mickley Road. Continue .5 mile to the next stop sign. The Helfrich Springs Grist Mill is on your right and the Peter Grim Homestead is on your left, located on the north corner of Mickley and Lehnert Roads.

History

Built by Peter Grim in 1807, the Helfrich Springs Grist Mill was placed on the National Register of Historical Sites in 1977. The Whitehall Historical Preservation Society began preservation of the Helfrich Springs Grist Mill in 1984 with the hope that the mill would someday become the hub for all future projects and programs while standing as a museum of Whitehall Township's colorful and unique history.

Today, we have achieved that goal. The Helfrich Springs Grist Mill is open to the public for our regular monthly meetings, special events and by appointment. Call 610-776-7280 for hours.

Building preservation was accomplished with financial grants obtained from The Century Fund, the PA Historical and Museum Commissions, The Lehigh County Board of Commissioners, SPOOM and the Whitehall Township Commissioners and Recreation Commission along with fundraising events and generous public contributions.

Located across the street from the Grist Mill is the Peter Grim Homestead, which was the miller's residence, built in 1834. In October 1999, this building was also placed on the National Register of Historical Sites. Restoration is in progress and plans are to reflect a circa 1840's era home. A genealogical research library as well as the Society's office headquarters are located in this building.

- Walking tours of historical sites in the township
